In consideration for the opportunity to participate in the Camp, the Participant (or parent/guardian as Participant is a minor) acknowledges and accepts the risks of injury associated with participation in and transportation to and from the Camp. The Participant's parent/guardian accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury or other loss sustained during the Camp or during transportation to and from the Camp, as well as for any medical treatment rendered to the Participant that is authorized by the Camp, Fairlawn Community Church or its agents, employees, volunteers, or any other representatives (collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Activity Sponsor"). Further, the Participant's parent/guardian releases and promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Activity Sponsor for any injury arising directly or indirectly out of the Camp or transportation to and from the Camp, whether such injury arises out of the negligence of the Activity Sponsor, the Participant, or otherwise.

If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the Participant's parent/guardian agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the Participant's parent/guardian and the Activity Sponsor cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel for resolution pursuant to the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
